

We Abraham Sandys of Kiltormer and John Allman of Eyecourt Esqrs Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth intituled an act to provide for the establishing of compositions for tythes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tythes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of ~~Midleton~~ the county of Galway do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tythes whatsoever within the said Parish is one hundred and six pounds by the year of which sum of one hundred and six pounds sterling thirty six pounds sterling is due and payable to the Rev J Strange ~~Bishop~~ Arch Deacon of the said Parish forty pounds sterling is due and payable to the Rev Richard Eyre as vicar of the said Parish thirty pounds sterling is due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Cloyne and we do further certify that the average price of oats being the corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 twenty one shillings and six pence by the barrel given under our hands and seals this thirteenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty three
