

We Abraham Sandys of Stillmore and John Allan of ~~1821~~ ¹⁸²² Commissioners duly appointed and sworn in and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth intitled an act to provide for the establishing of compositions for tythes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and for a true and just composition for all tythes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Mellick in the county of Galway do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tythes whatever within the said Parish is one hundred and six pounds by the year of which sum of one hundred and six pounds Sterling is due and payable to the Rev^d J. Strange Bulson as Arch^d Deacon of the said Parish thirty pounds Sterling is due and payable to the Rev^d Richard Eyre as vicar of the said parish thirty pounds Sterling is due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocess of Confort and we do further certify that the average price of oats being the corn principally grown in such county for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 twenty one shillings and six pence by the barrel given in witness whereof we have signed and seals this thirteenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty two
