duly appointed and sworn under, and by Virtue of an Act
made in the Second and Third Year of *William the*
Fourth, entitled "An Act to amend Three Acts passed
respectively in the 4th, 5th, and 7th and 8th Years of the
Reign of his late Majesty, *King George the Fourth*, provi-
ding for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," to
ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all
TITHES arising, growing, yielded or payable, within the
Parish of *Monamolin in the Diocess of Ferns and*
in the County of *Wexford* — do hereby certify that
the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatever within the said Parish, is *£461* — Pounds
— Shillings and — Pence by the Year,
of which Sum of *£461* — Pounds — Shillings
and — Pence are due and payable to the

following Persons, as a Composition for the Tithe
claimable by them, viz: — *£401* — Payable to the Rev.^d
Thomas Ottwell Moore of Leshinfern Glebe and Rector of said Parish
and the Sum of *£60* — to the Rev.^d *William Fitzsimons of*
Monamolin Glebe and perpetual Curate of same Payable
out of the Townlands of *Crimatublin and Glance which said*
£60 — I have increased from the average *£51.6.6* from a conviction
that the Tithes for the seven years preceding Nov. 1830 were underlet

And I do further certify that the Average Price of *Wheat*
— being the Corn principally grown in such
County, for the Period of Seven Years, ending on the first
Day of *November 1830* is *£1. 12. 0*
Shillings per Barrel.
