amount of Composition for All Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is Four Hundred Pounds
by the Year and which sum of Four Hundred
Pounds by the Year is due and payable to the
Reverend George Spaight as a Composition for
the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of said
Parish

And we do further certify that the
average price of Oats being the Corn principally
grown in the County of Cork for the period of
seven years ending the first day of November
One thousand Eight Hundred and twenty one is
~~Twenty one Shillings per Barrell~~
