Michaelmas Quarter Sessions 1895.

By the justices assigned to keep the
Peace in the County of Limerick at the
Quarter Sessions holden in the County
of the City of Limerick in and for the
Limerick Division of and for the said
County of Limerick on the twelfth
day of October 1895.

Whereas due notice having been first
duly given in writing and signed by 3
persons being each a person and owner of
land in the Parish of Manisternagh otherwise
called Manister in the diocese of Limerick
Baronies of Kubblebrien and Small County
and Division of Limerick in the said County
of Limerick each charged with the annual
payment of the sum of £3. sterling and
upwards each in respect of the rent charge
payable in lieu of the composition for
tithes within the said Parish made by the
Certificate of Hugh Finch and Richard White
dated the 28th day of April 1826 in pursuance
of
