Manister in the Diocese of Limerick in the
 Barony of Kibblereen and Small County
 in the said Division of Limerick and in the
 County of Limerick shall be diminished in
 such manner and to such extent that the
 amount of such composition payable for and
 during the 7 years from the first day of November
 1895 (being the first of November next ensuing
 this order) shall bear the like proportion to
 the amount of the composition set forth in the
 said Certificate dated the 28th day of April 1826
 as the said sum of £0:17:10¼ the average price
