an Act Passed in the second and Third years of the
Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth entitled
"An Act to amend three acts passed respectively in
the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth
years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George
the Fourth, provided for the establishing of Compos-
itions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such
Compositions permanent, and to ascertain and
fix, a true and just Composition for all Tithes,
arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the
the Parish of Monasteran, in the County of Kil-
dare" - do hereby certify that the true and just
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
in the said Parish is one hundred and twenty
nine pence, fifteen shillings and eight pence
by the year, of which sum of £129..15..8 the whole
