

We Thomas Lancaster of Fortwilliam in the County of Roscommon  
and Walter Lambert Esq of St. Ellens in the County of Galway Esq  
duly appointed and sworn as Commissioners under and by virtue  
of an act of Parliament made in the fourth year of the Reign of King  
George the Fourth intitled an act to provide for the Establishment  
of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, and ano-  
ther act made to amend said Act, in the fifth year of the Reign  
of King George the Fourth, for providing for the Establishment of Com-  
positions for Tithes in Ireland in order to ascertain and fix a true &  
just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded and pay-  
able within the Parish of Abbot in the Union of Athlone, Arch-  
diocese of Surmand County of Galway. Do hereby Certify that  
the true and just amount of all Tithes whatsoever within the  
said Parish, pursuant to agreement between the Tithe Owners  
and the Parishioners and persons paying Tithes in said Parish  
is three hundred and forty five pounds eighteen shillings & ten  
pence & is payable half yearly from the first day of November  
One thousand eight hundred & twenty six by equal sales on every  
first day of May and first day of November in every year of the  
sum three hundred and thirty eight pounds eight shillings & ten pence & is  
due and payable to the Right the Venerable Archbishop C. P. French  
the Rector of his successors in equal proportions as aforesaid as a Composition  
for the Vicarage by him as Rector of said Parish and seven pounds ten shil-  
lings that the Remainder is due and payable to the Rev. Henry Mervin as  
Rector of St. Mary's, in equal proportions as aforesaid as a Composition  
for Tithes claimable by him as such Rector in said Parish. And  
we do further Certify that the Average Price of Wheat being the Com-  
monly grown in that part of said County for the period

of seven years ending the first day of November One thousand  
and eight hundred and twenty One is One pound eighteen  
shillings and eight pence half penny per Borell.
