Ireland for a limited Time To ascertain and fix a true
and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded
or payable within the Parish of Castropeter otherwise
Edenderry in the King's County Do hereby certify that
the true and just Amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Four hundred and
Fifty pounds Starting by the year of which sum of Four
- hundred and Fifty Pounds Twentieths are due and payable
to the Rev^d J. Strange Butson, as a Composition for all
Tithes claimable by Him as Rector of the said parish
and one third of the above Four hundred and fifty Pounds
is due and payable to the Rev^d John Jones as owner of the
Vicarial Tithes of the said Parish.

And We do further Certify that the
average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown
in this County for the period of Seven years ending
the first day of November 1821 is Seventeen Shilling
16^d per Barrel Given under our hands this 28 day
of June 1824.
