duly Registered and Enrolled and bearing date the twenty ninth day of November one thousand
 eight hundred and seven on Lands of ^{Monast. Ashingory, Maston, Ballinacorney, Corck, russia, Garnishanone, Lye, Cherrybrook}
^{Tomgarr, Ballinacorney, Tommashippun, Ballinalhallin, Ballinacorney, Millhouse and Aquinchoon, Dullin, Lye}
 All which said Town Lands are situate in the Diocese and County aforesaid

or Chapel to be erected on the Lands of Monast

as aforesaid and to be thereafter one Parish to be called
 (as in said Deed mentioned) and to be deemed and reputed to be one entire Parish for the
 exercise of Rights as Rectors of said Parish as by the said Deed and Registry and Enrolment thereof with
 the said Act duly nominated by the said Henry Wynne to the said Bishop to be licenced by him
 the said Bishop did duly licence the said Thomas Hampur accordingly And the said Thomas

And Whereas a Competant Glebe has been purchased by the Trustees and

 the Rector or Incumbant of the Parish wherout such perpetual Cure should be Curate or his
 Bishop or Bishops of the Diocese or their Successors the Patrons of the Rectory and the Dean
