Made the twentyfifth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and seven 1807 and Between The Reverend Henry Wynne,  
Rector of the parish of Temple Shanbo in the Diocese of Ferns and County of  
Wexford or Curacy of Kilnart in the Diocese aforesaid of the second part The Right  
Shanbo in the said Diocese of the third part The Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral of  
Ferns by virtue of a Certain Act of Parliament passed in Ireland in the eleventh and twelfth years of  
the reign of King James the First Extent and making such Chapels and those that are already founded  
or of perpetual Curates to officiate in the same and also in like manner for making  
of Leighlin and Ferns did by writing under his Hand and Episcopal Seal with the Consent  
and Conder His Hand and Seal duly set out and describe the bounds and several Towns in  
new Church or Chapel to be a perpetual Cure within the said Parish of Temple  
thus Registered and Enrolled and bearing date the twenty ninth day of November one thousand  
in Lands of Mount - Mellingory - Newton - Ballinane - Crochetupis - Garrisonane - Tyre - Cherry Orchard  
Bogland - Chairwood - Cothman Wood - Holdew Wood - Stackaberry Wood - Lismore - Knock - Hilltown  
Tomgarvan - Ballyduffy - Tommahippen - Ballinalacken - Ballyoral - Milehouse and Asquinton - Quillen - Town  
all which said Town Lands are situate in the Diocese and County aforesaid  
in Chapel to be erected on the lands of Mounts -  
aforesaid and to be thereafter one Parish to be called  
(as in said Deed mentioned) and to be deemed and reputed to be one entire Parish for the  
use Rights as Rector of said Parish as by the said Deed and Registry and Enrollment thereof in  
said Act duly Nominated by the said Henry Wynne to the said Bishop to be licenced by him  
said Bishop did duly licence the said Thomas Hanpur accordingly And the said Thomas  
**And** Whereas a Competant Glebe has been purchased by the ~~\*\*~~ Trustees and

Lands and wherewith the said Curate and his Successors have been lately duly Endowed **And**  
the Rector or Incumbent of the Parish whereout such perpetual Cure should lie Curated or His  
Bishop or Bishop of the Diocese or their Successors the Patrons of the Rectory and the Dean  
parties to and affixing their Seals to such writing Endow any such Cure with a Competant portion  
Rector or Incumbent and His Successors
