Machaffy Vest Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under  
and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign  
of King George the fourth, intituled, an Act to provide for the  
establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited  
time to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all  
Tithes arising growing yielding or payable within the Parish of  
Monkstown in the County of Dublin do hereby certify that the  
true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever  
within the said Parish is Two hundred and Twenty One  
Pounds Nine Shillings and eight pence by the year. of  
which sum the whole amount is due and payable to the  
Rev. Charles Lindsay Vest, as a Composition for the Tithes claim-  
able by him as Perpetual Incumbent of said Parish.

And we do further certify, that the average Price of Wheat  
being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the  
period of seven years ending on the First day of November  
1821 pursuant to a Schedule furnished by ~~the~~ <sup>Barrel</sup>  
the Right Honble Henry Goulburn Chief Sec. to the Lord  
Lieutenant of Ireland is One Pound Eighteen Shillings  
& eight pence halfpenny per Barrel.
