judice or Malice to any person or  
Persons whomsoever. and I do further  
swear That I am seized of a Freehold  
Property of the clear yearly value of two Hundred  
Pounds ~~at~~ arising out of the Leases  
of Ault's Lake, in the Parish of Wexham  
& County of Tipperary, of which I have  
a term of Years renewable for ever
