Moor pursuant to an agreement Between the Tithe Owners
and the Parishioners and persons paying Tithes in said Parish
is two Hundred and twenty four pounds ten Shillings that
by the year payable half yearly on every first day of May
and first day of November in equal parts of which sum twelve
pounds that per Annum are due and payable to the being
Rev^d Tho^s Hawkins as Composition for the Tithes Claimable
by him as Dean of Clonfert &c and the sum of Two Hundred
and twelve pounds ten Shillings that being the Remainder
is due and payable to the Rev^d James Anderson as a Com-
position for all Tithes Claimable by him as Rector or Incum-
bent of said Parish, And we do further Certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in said
County for the period of seven years ending the first day of
November One thousand eight Hundred and twenty one
is fifteen Shillings and two pence that per Barrele late &c
