for Tithes in Ireland, and to substitute Rent Charges
"in lieu thereof, and for other purposes," To ascertain
and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes
arising, growing, yielded or payable, within the
Townlands of Richardstown, and Scareletstown, other-
wise Scareletstown, being part of the Parish of Morristown, Diocese
of Kildare, Barony of Connell, and County of Kildare,
Do hereby Certify, that the true and just amount of Com-
position for all Tithes whatsoever in the said Townland, is
Nineteen pounds, Two shillings, and five pence Sterling
by the year, the whole of which is due, and payable,
to John Smyth of Number Seventeen, Eustace Street, in the
City of Dublin Solicitor, as Lay, Impreciator; and
I do further Certify, that the average price of wheat, being the
Corn principally grown in such County for the period of
Seven years ending on the 1st day of November 1830, thirty,
is one pound, Thirteen shillings and one penny per Barrell.
