

We William Mills and James Kelly, Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue
of an Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign of
King George the Fourth, intituled an Act to pro-
vide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tythes
in Ireland for a Limited time. bearing date
the 19.th July 1823 shew, to ascertain and fix a true
and Just Composition for all Tythes arising
growing, Yielded, or pay able within the Parish
of Lagworthstown Alias Mastrim in the County
of Longford, do hereby Certify, that the true and
Just Amount of Composition for all Tythes
whatsoever within the said Parish is Three hundred
and Fifty Seven pounds due by the year,
of which Sum of Three hundred and Fifty Seven
pounds, Two hundred and Thirty pounds are due
£230 and pay able to the Rev. George Meating as a
Composition for the Tythes claimable by him
as Vicar of the said Parish. And also that the
Sum of Sixty pounds, being a part of the above
Three hundred and Fifty Seven pounds, are due
and pay able to Anthony Shoin as a Composition
for the Tythes claimable by him as Lay Impropri-
ator arising out of the different Town lands in
said Parish viz. Cloncaugh, Pungewny.
