

To all, to whom these presents shall come, I the King's Justice
Incumbent of the Parish of Mastrom in the County of Longford send greeting
Whereas, George G. Hinds of Quinpark in the County of Westmeath has truly assured
me with a notice in the words and figures following,
In you are hereby required to take notice, that in pursuance of an act passed
in the second and third years of the reign of his present Majesty King William
the fourth Entitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the 4, 5 and
in the 7 and 8 years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing
for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such
Composition permanent. I George Hinds of Quinpark in the County
Westmeath, Agent to Louell Edgeworth of Edgeworth's house Esq^r County Longford
and to Charles Lloyd Edgeworth Esq^r of Little Harolds in the County of
West England who are seized in fee of the Lands and premises hereinafter
particularly Described That is to say, the Town Lands of Garrymore,
Edgeworthstown Aughrim, Tinnin, Aughrane, Aughranoragh, the
Motes and bounds are as follow, that is to say bounded on the North by the
Town Land of Cromlymore and Liphavacagh, on the West by the Glebe
Lands of Mastrom and the Town Land of Braekland, on the South
by the Town Lands of Camliskmore, Ballinacragh, Sherrinstown and
Liscashill, and on the East by the Town Lands of Curry, Cowlage, Whinney
Also the Town Land of Luceken the motes and bounds whereof are as follows
That is to say bounded on the north by the Town Land of Braeklin, on the west
by the Town Lands of Liphavacagh on the South by the Town Lands of Aughranoragh
and on the East by the Town Lands of Camlisk. Also the Town Land
of Bilsowry the motes and bounds whereof are as follow, that is to say bounded
on the North by the Town Lands of Courtton-Cur, on the south by the
Town Lands of Cromlymore, and on the East by the Town Lands of Gully,
and on the West by the Town Lands of Cromlymore, which said Towns
and Lands are situate lying and being in the Parish of Mastrom
Barony of Uolagh and County of Longford, and otherwise Entitled
according to the provisions of said act, to agree for and undertake the
payment for Compositions for tithes lawfully payable for and on
