Send greeting. Whereas Georgina West of Donaghadee in the County of  
Down & Strabane has lately served me with a Notice in writing in the  
words and figures following  
Sir, you are hereby Required to take notice that in pursuance of an Act  
passed in the Second and Third years of his present Majesty, entitled  
"An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth,  
& in the Seventh & Eighth years of his late Majesty, King George the fourth  
Providing for Establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland, & and to  
make such Compositions permanent and also of another Act passed in  
the third & fourth years of the Reign of his present Majesty, Entitled an  
Act for the Relief of the owners of Tithes in Ireland, and for the amendment  
of said Act of the second and third years of the Reign of his present Majesty  
& Georgina West of Donaghadee in the County of Down & Strabane, who  
are Heirs of the said and premises hereinafter particularly described  
being Entitled according to the provisions of the said Acts to agree for and  
undertake the Payment of the Composition for the vicarial tithes, lawfully  
payable for and in respect of the said Tithes do hereby signify to you my  
Desire to agree for and undertake the payment of such Composition as  
aforesaid for and in respect of all that tract of land the Town lands of  
Creenlymore the Meads and Bounts whereof are as follows that is to say bounded  
on the North by the Town Land of Lisnald and Creenlymore on the South by  
the Town Lands of Whinnery and Tunnahawn on the East by the Town  
Land of Monagowney and on the West by the Town Land of Lefanagoragh  
& Anghafin which said Town Lands are situate Spring and King in the Parish  
of Miltown Down of the County of Longford and County of Longford and do hereby  
Require you to grant to me a Certificate in writing conformable to the provisions  
of the said Acts claiming me Entitled to the benefit of this statute and to  
perform the other Matters on your part required by the said Acts to be  
Done. Dated this 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1834
