Wall and the two Misses Hardy appointed William Gilbert of Waterford Accountant to be Arbitrator for ascertaining the average price per barrel of Oats as advertised in the Dublin Gazette during the seven years preceding said Application and it appearing to the said Justices by an attested Office Copy of the Certificate of composition dated the 18th day of April 1827 that the average price of Oats per barrel for the seven years ending with the year 1821 was 14/0⁴ per barrel and that in consequence thereof the Commissioners appointed pursuant to the Statute in such case made and provided by his said certificate fixed the amount of composition for Tithes in the said Parish of Mothel at £856 sterling by the year of which said Composition of £856 the sum of £316 was due and payable by the year to the Rev. Daniel H. Wall and the two Misses Hardy jointly as a composition claimable by them for the Rectorial tithes of said Parish and that Oats was the measure of composition for the said Parish And it further appearing by the report in writing of the said William Gilbert under his hand delivered to the Justices at said Sessions that the average price of Oats for the last seven years was 11/10 stg per barrel according to the returns published in the Dublin Gazette And that the Rent Charge payable to the said Representatives of the Rev. Daniel H. Wall and the two Misses Hardy jointly in lieu of the composition claimable by them was £237 per annum being $\frac{3}{4}$ ths of the said sum of £316 And it further appearing that the said Composition of £316 and the said Rent Charge of £237 so as aforesaid payable to the said Representatives of the Rev. Daniel H. Wall and the two Misses Hardy jointly in lieu of the said Composition claimable by them have been reduced by purchase-redemption or otherwise the said Composition to the sum of £101. 9. 0 and the said Rent charge to the sum of £76. 0. 9 And upon hearing the evidence given before said Justices in Open Court It is Ordered by the said Justices that the said sum of £101. 9. 0 now representing the said sum of £316 as aforesaid being the composition mentioned in said certificate as payable to the said Rev. Daniel H. Wall and the two Misses Hardy jointly be diminished by the sum of £15. 16. 7 and that the same shall be £85. 12. 5 annually and that pursuant to the Statute of 1 and 2 Victoria Cap. 109 the Rent Charge in lieu of said reduced Composition of £85. 12. 5 shall be three fourths thereof that is to say a sum of £64. 4. 3 annually to be paid and payable to the parties entitled and that the same shall commence and be payable from the 1st day of May 1890 And it is further Ordered that the assessment and applotment of the said composition shall be amended accordingly and that the applotment of the Rectorial Tithe Rent Charge in lieu of said composition so payable to the said Reps of the said Rev. Daniel H. Wall and the two Misses Hardy be reduced and diminished in like proportion And it is further Ordered that the applicants do pay to the said Reps of the said Daniel H. Wall and the two Misses Hardy the sum of £3. 3. 0 for their Costs charges and expenses of appearing on such application and of varying and ascertaining the amount of such composition and Rent Charge and the applotment thereof respectively and to the said William Gilbert the sum of £2. 2. 0 for his fee in respect of said Arbitration.
