

Mr William Pross & Patrick W. Grull Esqrs Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an
Act, passed in the Fourth year of King George the
Fourth, Chap 99. Intituled an Act to provide for
the Establisment of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland for a limited time "to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all the Vicarial
Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within
the Parish of Mottel, Diocese of Waterford and County
of Waterford, do Certify that at a Special Vestry
held on the 5th day of September last, in the Parish
Church of Mottel, it was then & there agreed
by and between the said Special Vestry and
the Rev. Henry Stewart P. P. Vicar of Mottel
that the sum of Five Hundred and Eighty five
pounds Sterling should stand and be a fair
and just Composition for all the Vicarial Tithes
of said Parish of Mottel; annually for the
space of 21 years from the above date.

And we find that the said sum of
Five Hundred and Eighty five pounds Ster. is
due and payable to the Rev. Henry Stewart and
his Successors as Vicars of the Parish of Mottel,
annually - payable half yearly viz on the 1st day
of May and first day of November in each year
next at Mottel this 17th day of October 1825
and we find the average price of Oats being the Corn
most usually grown in said parish for the above years
to be $\frac{1}{2}$ p. 10 s. 6 d. to be
