reign of George the 4th ^{the chap. 99} intituled "An Act to
provide for the establishing of Compositions
for all Tithes in Ireland for a limited time"
To fix and ascertain a true and just Compo-
sition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded,
or payable within the Parish of Mottel, in
the Diocese of Lismore and County of Waterford,
do find that the true and just amount of
the Improprate Tithes in said Parish payable
to the Rev. Daniel H. Wall and the Two Messrs
Hardy, jointly, to be the sum of Three Hundred
and sixteen pounds British payable annually
for the Tithes of Two thirds of the Corn grown in
said Parish, and we further find that the sum
of Five Hundred and forty pounds ^{British} are due and
payable to the Rev. Henry Stewart, D.D. and his
Successors as Vicars of said Parish. All said
Tithes being payable annually viz on the first
day of May and first day of November in
