

It is hereby agreed on by the Rev<sup>d</sup> Henry Stewart D.D., Vicar of the Parish of Mothel in the Diocese of Lismore and County of Waterford, and by a Special-Vestry duly held for said Parish, pursuant to the provisions of the 4<sup>th</sup> of George the 4<sup>th</sup> Chapter 99, entitled an Act for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, for a limited time, that the sum of Five Hundred and Eighty five pounds, shall be paid as the annual composition under the said Act, for all the Vicarial Tithes payable out of said Parish of Mothel to the said Rev<sup>d</sup> Henry Stewart, Vicar of Mothel. — Dated this 8<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1825.
