an Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes  
in Ireland for a limited time) to Ascertain and fix a true and  
just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable  
within the Parish of Mournabby in the County of Cork

do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Compositions  
for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Six hundred  
Pounds by the year which sum of Six hundred Pounds is  
due and payable to the Rev. Arthur Herbert as a Composition  
for said Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish

And we do further Certify that the average Price of  
Oats (being the Corn principally grown in the County of Cork)  
for the Period of seven years ending on the First day of November  
one thousand eight hundred and twenty one is Fifteen Shillings  
and two pence farthing per Barrel as calculated from the Returns  
advertized in the Dublin Gazette during such seven years
