fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth
entitled an Act to provide for the establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
time, to ascertain and fix a true & just
composition for all Tithes arising growing
yielded or payable within the Parish of
Mourne Abbey in the County of Cook

do hereby certify that the true & just am-
ount of Composition for all Tithes whatso-
ever within the said Parish is six hundred
Pounds by the year, which sum of six
hundred Pounds is due and payable to
the Rev^d Arthur Herbert as a composition
for said Tithes claimable by him as
Rector of the said Parish

And we do further certify that the
average price of oats (being the Corn prin-
cipally grown in the County of Cook) for the
period of seven years ending on the first
day of November one thousand eight hun-
-dred and twenty one is fifteen shillings
and two pence ^{fourpence} per barrel as calculated from
the Returns advertised in the Dublin Gazette
during such seven years
