

To ALL whom these Presents shall come, I *Richard William Amshurst*  
Incumbent of the Parish of *Tanybrogue*  
in the County of Longford send Greeting, WHEREAS, *John R Robinson*  
in the County of *Longford* has truly served me with a Notice in Writing, in  
the Words and Figures following,

SIR,—You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the  
second and third year of his present Majesty, entitled, an Act to amend three Acts passed respec-  
tively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty,  
King George the Fourth, providing for establishing of COMPOSITION of TITHES in Ireland,  
and to make such Compositions permanent, I *John R Robinson*  
of *Lipshapick* in the County of *Longford* agents and  
being *for the benefit of Countess Dowager of Drogheda* of All That and Those,  
*being seized in fee*

*The Land of Abbeydarlick*

situate in the Parish of *Tanybrogue* Barony of *Moydow* and  
County of *Longford* or otherwise entitled, according to the Provisions of said  
Act, to agree for and undertake the Payment of the Composition for Tithes lawfully payable for  
and in respect of such Lands, do hereby signify to you my desire to agree for and undertake the  
Payment of such Composition as aforesaid, for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby re-  
quire you to grant me a Certificate in Writing, conformable to the Provisions of said Act, declaring  
*Said to be* entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters on your part required  
by the said Act to be done.

said Parish of *Tanybrogue* do by this Certificate, under my hand and  
seal, acknowledge the receipt of said Notice, and do certify and declare, that the said  
*Countess Dowager of Drogheda*  
is entitled to the benefit of such Notice, pursuant to the Provisions of the said Act, so far as  
relates to the several Lands and Premises in said Notice mentioned, and charged with the Com-  
position for Tithes for said Parish, and which Lands are more particularly set forth in the Map  
hereunto annexed.
