We John Lucas and Simon O'Donnell Commissioners duly Appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth intituled "An Act to provide for the Establish^{ment} of Composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time" and also an Act made in the Fifth Year of the reign of the said King intituled "An Act to Amend the same" do Assent and give a just and true composition for all tithes arising growing yealding or payable within the Parish of Moyarta in the County of Clare do hereby Certify That at a special Vestry duly Assembled at Clarefield in the said Parish of Moyarta on the Twelfth day of February One thousand eight hundred and Twenty Six for the purpose of carrying into Execution the purposes of the said Acts The Reverend Incumbent of said Parish of Moyarta did then and there enter into an Agreement with the Chairman and members of the Vestry assembled that the sum of One Hundred and twenty pounds of the late Irish currency shall be Annually paid to the said Ecclesiastical Incumbent for the vicarial tithes of said Parish and the sum of One Hundred and thirteen pounds of said Irish currency shall be paid said Incumbent for his part of the Rectorial or Subaltern tithes of the said Parish of Moyarta and also that Mr. Anthony Nolan & Hugh O'Shea on the part of the Right Hon. Lord Castlecoote did enter into an Agreement with the said Vestry

so assembled that the sum of One Hundred and Twenty Six pounds Six shillings and eight pence of the like currency shall be Annually paid to the said Lord Castlecoote in lieu of his lay Impropriate tithes of the said Parish of Moyarta amounting in the whole to the sum of One Hundred and Ten pounds of the afore said Irish currency for the whole tithes of the said Parish of Moyarta which sum we consider a just and fair composition for the whole of the tithes of the said Parish of Moyarta and further that such composition shall be and remain in full force and effect for the whole space of Twenty one years and shall not be subject to any variation in the amount thereof during such period of Twenty one years whatsoever may be the price of corn
