for a limited time and an Act made in the Second and Third year
of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth to amend three
Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and six the seventh
and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George
the Fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes
in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, to
ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes aris-
ing growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Clonagal
alias Moyacomb in the Counties of Carlow Wexford and Wicklow
do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Compositions for
all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is eight hundred
and fifty pounds by the year, all of which sum of eight hundred
and fifty pounds by the year is due and payable to the Reverend
Alexander McChinlock as a Composition for the tithe claimable
by him as Rector of said Parish and I do further certify that the
average price of Oats (being the Corn principally grown in such
Counties) for the period of seven years ending on the first day of
November One thousand eight hundred and thirty is fifteen
shillings and three pence three farthings by the Banel, Dated this
Twenty second day of April one thousand eight hundred and
thirty three
