

You are hereby required to take notice that in pursuance of an act passed in the second and third years of his Majesty King William the fourth entitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth seventh & eighth years of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for establishing permanent compositions — I Michael George Croker of Newtownbarry holding by lease of lives renewable for ever from the representatives of the late Matthew Hagerly that part of the lands of Coolmelagh called Beanfield the metes and bounds whereof are as follow — Bounded on the north by Glanashnick on the south bynd east by Prospect on the west by Prospect and Garihastin situate in the parish of Moyacomb Barony of Scarawalsh and county of Wexford or being otherwise intituled according to the provisions of said act to agree for and undertake the payment of the composition for tithes, lawfully payable for and in respect of the said lands do hereby signify to you my desire to agree and undertake the payment of such compositions and I hereby require you to grant me a certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions of the said act declaring me entitled to the benefit of this notice and to perform the other matters on your part required by the said act to be done.
