virtue of an act made in the 4<sup>th</sup> year of the reign  
of King George the 4<sup>th</sup> entitled "An act to provide  
for the establishing of compositions for tithes in  
Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain & fix a  
true & just composition for all tithes arising growing  
yielded or payable within the Parish of Moilough  
in the county of Meath, do hereby certify, That the  
true & just amount of composition for all tithes  
whatsoever within the said parish is two hundred  
pounds by the year due & payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Vicar  
B. Vincent as a composition for the tithes claimable  
by him as Rector of the said parish. And we  
do further certify <sup>according to the official return from the Dublin Gazette</sup> that the average price of oats  
being the corn principally grown in such county,  
for the period of seven years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day  
of November 1821 is fifteen shillings & two pence  
farthing per barrel. — Signed
