payable to the Rev^d George Alley as a composition
for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said
Parish

And We do further Certify that the Average
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown
in such County for the Period of Seven Years
ending on the First day of November One Thousand
Eight Hundred and Twenty One is One Pound Eighteen
Shillings and Eight Pence Sterling per Barrel
December 30th 1824
