

Certificate for Composition of Tithes for Auckee Parish by the Commissioners

We Hugh Garmany and John Matthews Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth. Subscribed and act for the Composition of Tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding or payable within the Parish of Auckee in the County of Monaghan do hereby Certify that the amount of composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the bounds of Auckee is Four Hundred and Seventy two Shillings ten Pence sterling by the year being the amount agreed upon Between the Rev^d Henry Herbert Vicar of the said Parish and the Commissioners duly assembled at Vestry on the 27th day of July one Thousand eight Hundred and Twenty five under and out of which sum of Four Hundred and Seventy two Shillings ten Pence sterling is due and payable to the said Henry Herbert as Rector of said Parish of Auckee and we do further Certify that the average price of Oats being the Corn principally growing in said Parish in said County for the period of seven years ending on the 4th day November one Thousand eight Hundred and Twenty one - is fifteen Shillings and two pence Halfpenny - and We in order to prevent Litigation at the expiration of this agreement for Composition of Tithes do further Certify and declare that the only thing for which Tithes has been heretofore paid in said Parish of Auckee is Wheat Rye Bere Barley and Oats - Dated October 4th 1825
