

We Hugh Garmony and John Mathews Commissioners duly
Appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the Fourth Year
of the Reign of King George the Fourth, Entitled an Act for the Composition
of Tithes in Ireland, to ascertain and fix a true and Just Composition for all
Tithes arising growing yielding or payable within the Parish of Muckno in
the County of Monaghan, do hereby Certify that the amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatever within the Parish of Muckno is Four Hundred and Seventy two
Pounds Ten Shillings Sterling by the Year being the Amount agreed upon Between
the Rev^d Thomas Hackett Incumbent of the said Parish and the Parishioners duly
assembled at Vestry on the 27th day of July one Thousand Eight Hundred and
Twenty Five, under said Act all which Sum of Four Hundred and Seventy two
Pounds Ten Shillings Sterling, is due and payable to the said Rev^d Thomas Hackett
as Rector of said Parish of Muckno, and We do further Certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in said Parish in said County
in the Period of seven Years ending on the 1st Day of November one
Thousand Eight Hundred and twenty One is Fifteen Shillings and two pence
halfpenny, and We in order to prevent Litigation at the Expiration of this
agreement for Composition of Tithes do further Certify and declare that the
only thing for which Tithe has been hitherto paid in the said Parish of
Muckno is Wheat, Rye, Oats, Barley and Oats.
