fifty pounds Sterling are due and payable to the Dean
and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of St Flannan
Killaloe as a Composition for the tithes Claimable
by the S^d Dean and Chapter for the vicarial tithes
of S^d Parish and forty pounds Sterling are due and
payable to the Rev^d Hugh W. Hubert the Vicar of
S^d parish Dated this 9th Day of April 1825
