

By the Justices assigned to keep the Peace in and for the County of Cork assembled at a General Quarter Sessions of the Peace holden at Bantry in and for the Division of Skibbereen in the next Riding of the County of Cork on the seventeenth day of July one thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Six

Whereas due notice having been first affixed at the times and in the manner directed by the Statutes in such case made and provided by John Simnick John Hancock Townsend Daniel Kelply and Edward Powell Esquires four persons owners of Land in the Parish of Myross in the Division of Skibbereen and in the next Riding of the County of Cork each charged with the annual payment of the sum of Three Pounds and upwards in respect of the Rent charge payable in lieu of composition for tithes within said Parish made by the Certificate of composition bearing date the thirtieth day of August one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight and in pursuance of the Statute in such case made and provided whereby it was certified that the true and just composition for all Tithes whatever within said Parish was the annual sum of Five hundred Pounds Sterling they the said owners of land made application in writing to the said Justices of the Peace at the Quarter Sessions above mentioned to have the average price of wheat with reference to which the variation of the Rent charged in lieu of Tithe composition in the said Parish should take place as same appears in the Dublin Gazette for the preceding seven years in the statute in such case made and provided in that behalf mentioned and for such other period as might be necessary inquired of and ascertained in order that the said composition for Tithes and the Tithe Rent charge payable in lieu thereof might be diminished according to such average price as compared with the price of the same description of Grain during the period of years with reference whereto the composition in said Parish was calculated,
