

Parish having appeared by their respective Agents before the said Justices at such Quarter Sessions and the said notice of application, Certificate and other documents and the fact that wheat was the species of Corn principally grown in said County during said period of years with reference where to said composition was calculated having been proved, Now the said Justices do ascertain from the Dublin Gazette that the average price of the barrel of good marketable wheat for the seven years preceding the first November one thousand Eight hundred and twenty one was
one Pound eighteen and eight pence three farthings of the then currency of Ireland equivalent to the sum of one Pound fifteen shillings and nine pence present currency and that the average price of wheat for the said other period of seven years was one Pound ten shillings and eight pence per barrel of twenty stone and the said Justices do accordingly order and adjudge that the amount of said composition for tithes in said Parish and the rent charge payable in lieu thereof shall be diminished in proportion to the difference between the said average price of one Pound ten shillings and eight pence and the said average price of one pound fifteen shillings and nine pence and that the apportionment of said Composition shall be amended accordingly and the said Justices do further order and direct that the said reduction shall take effect from the first day of November One thousand Eight Hundred and fifty Six
