

Tithe Composition

I Silvester Rait having been duly appointed
& sworn Commissioner under & by virtue of an Act
made in the fourth year of the Reign of King
George the fourth, intituled an Act to provide
for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland for a limited time, & by virtue of an Act
passed in the second & third years of the Reign
of his Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled
" an Act to Amend three Acts passed respectively
in the fourth, fifth, & in the seventh, & eighth
years of the Reign of his late Majesty King
George the fourth providing for the establish-
" ing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, &
to make such Compositions permanent, & to
ascertain & fix a true & just Composition for
all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or
payable within the Parish of Mylerstown
in the County of Kildane, Do hereby Certify
that the true & just Amount of Composition
for all Tithes whatever, within the said Parish
is Seventy nine Pounds thirteen shillings &
ten pence farthing Stg. by the year, of which
the Sum of Twenty six Pounds eleven
shillings and three pence farthing Stg.
or one third, are due & payable to the Rev.^d
Charles Palmer as a Composition for the
Tithe Claimable by him as Owner of the
Vicarial Tithe, & that two thirds or the
Sum of Fifty three Pounds two
shilb.,
