

At Special Vestry held at St Paul
on the 3 July 1828

It is hereby agreed on by the W.
B. W. Bland entitled to part of the Rectorial
Tithes of the Parish of St Paul in
the Diocese and County of Middlesex and
by the Landholders of said Parish in the
aforesaid Diocese and County of Middlesex
assembled in Special Vestry duly held for
said parish pursuant to the provisions of the
11th of Geo 4th Cap 99 entitled an act for Establishing
compensation for Tithes in England for a
limited time that the sum of One hundred
and twenty pounds together with an Stalling
in the pound for collecting the same shall
be paid annually out of said parish of St Paul
in the following proportions namely to
the aforesaid W. B. W. Bland one half of
the aforesaid One hundred and twenty pounds
with an Stalling in the pound for collecting
On the 1st day of May 1830 and the other half
on the 1st day of November in the same year
the compensation for said Tithes to commence
in August 1829. The Landowners paying
the aforesaid B. W. Bland for the broken
period from August to November 1829 viz
