

W<sup>o</sup> E, Spencer William Walsh & Walter Henry Mansfield  
Commissioners, duly appointed and sworn under and by  
virtue of an Act made in the 4<sup>th</sup> Year of the Reign of King  
Geo 4<sup>th</sup> entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of  
Composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time to  
ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes  
arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish  
of Traas and County of Kildare, do hereby certify that  
the true amount of Composition for the Rectorial tithes with  
in said Parish (Purplake lands excepted) is one hundred  
and twenty six pounds, which sum was agreed on in spe-  
cial Vestry duly summoned and held for the purpose,  
and certified to us by the Chairman, then and there presiding,  
and we certify that the sum of one hundred and twenty six  
pounds, is due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Rob<sup>t</sup> W. Bland as  
a Composition for the Rectorial tithes claimable by him,  
as Rector of said Parish of Traas, the lands of Purplake  
excepted.

And we the said Commissioners do further  
certify that the true amount of Composition for the whole of  
tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable out of the lands  
of Purplake within the Parish of Traas and County of Kildare,  
is six pounds eleven shillings and nine pence, according to  
agreement certified to us by the Chairman at a special  
Vestry held for the purpose, and that the said sum of six pounds  
eleven shillings and nine pence, is entirely payable out of  
said lands of Purplake to the Rev<sup>d</sup> James Stator.
