

I Frederick W. Edwards Commissioner duly appointed and sworn
under and by virtue of an act made in the second and third years
of the reign of King William the Fourth entitled "An Act to amend
three acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh
and eighth years of his late Majesty King George the Fourth"
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes
arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Kaul
in the Diocese of Dublin Do hereby certify that the true
and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is one hundred and forty seven
Pounds three shillings and two pence - of which sum of
£147.3.2 the sum of one hundred and thirty pounds
fifteen shillings is due and payable to William Dutton
Pollard of Castle Pollard in the County of Westmeath Esq.
as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as say
Impropriator of the said Parish and the sum of sixteen
Pounds Eight Shillings and Two pence, being the residue
of said sum of £147.3.2 is due and payable to the Revd
Thomas Baker as a Composition for the Tithes claimable
by him as Vicar of said Parish. And I do
further Certify that the average price of wheat being the
Corn principally grown in such Parish for the period of
seven years ending on the first day of November 1830 is
£1.12.10 $\frac{1}{2}$ per barrel. Dated the third day of
September 1835.
