Parish of Kavanagh

We have viewed and caused to be surveyed such parts of the said Parish of Kavanagh as from a want of Leases or Surveys appeared necessary and find it to contain one thousand seven hundred and thirty one Acres and two Roods of waste and pasture Lands subject to the payment of Compoition for Tithe. We have divided the several Lands in said Parish into four Clases - The first Clap to pay three shilling and two pence - the second Clap to pay three shilling and two pence fasting the third Clap to pay two shilling and six pence fasting and the fourth Clap to pay two shilling and one penny of Acre.
