To all to whom these presents shall come, I
the Rev^d. Edw^d. Barton Incumbent of the parish of Newbawn,
in the County of Wexford, send greeting. Whereas, Fran-
-cis Leigh in the County of Wexford Esq^r. has truly serv-
-ed me with a notice in writing, in the words and figures
following; viz: Sir, you are hereby required to take
notice that in pursuance of an act passed in the second and
third year of his present Majesty, entitled, "An act to a-
-mend three acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and
in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Ma-
-jesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing
of compositions for tithes in Ireland, and to make such com-
-positions permanent;" — I Francis Leigh of Rosegar-
-land, in the County of Wexford Esq^r. being proprietor
in Fee of all that and those the townlands of Newbawn
and Broonstown, situate in the parish of Newbawn, bar-
-ony of Shilmallier, and County of Wexford, or otherwise
entitled, according to the provisions of said act, to agree
for, and undertake the payment of the composition for
tithes, lawfully payable for and in respect of such lands;
Do hereby signify to you my desire to agree for and
undertake the future payment of such composition as
aforesaid, for and in respect of the said lands; and
I hereby require you to grant me a certificate in writing,
