

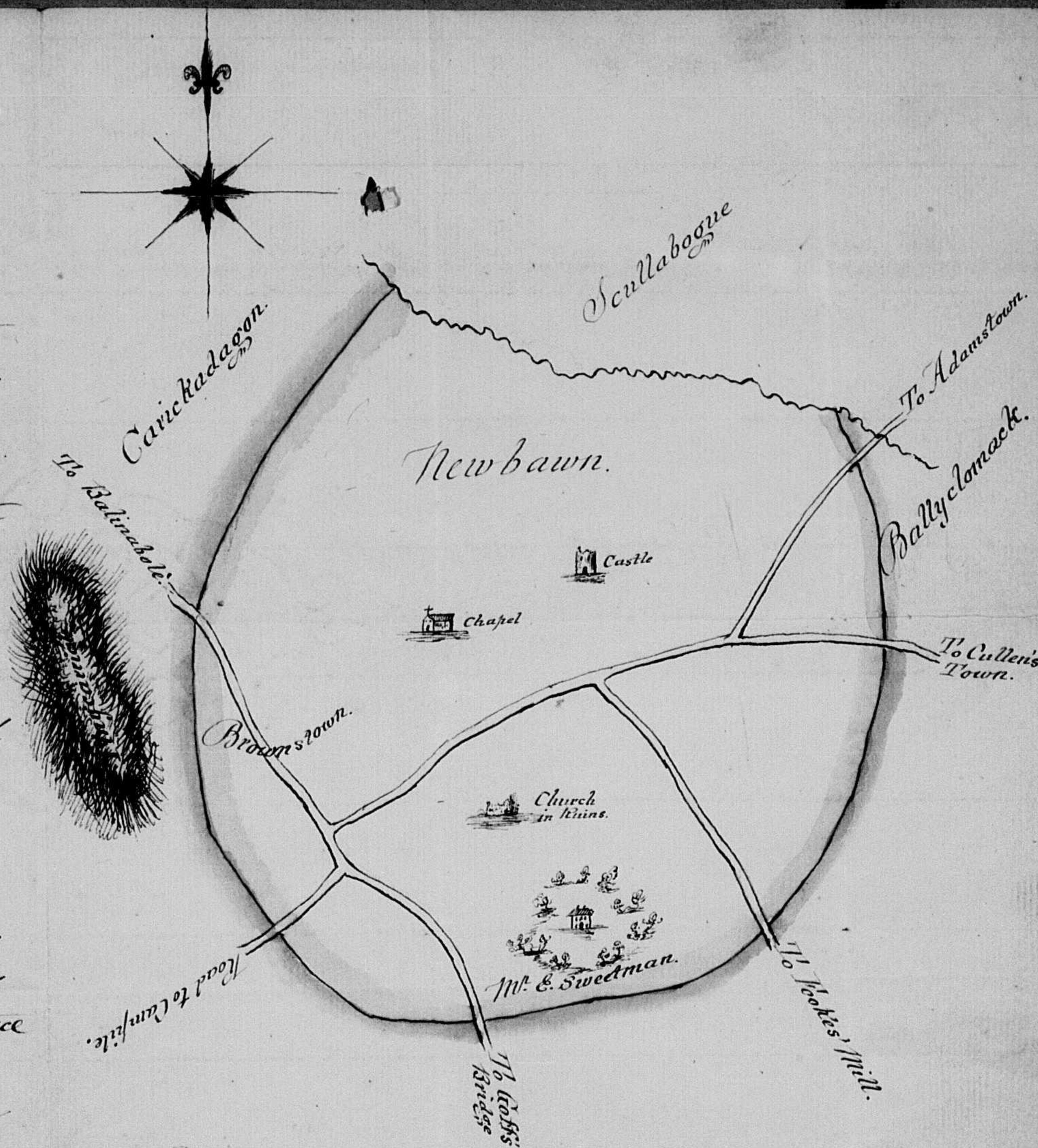

 veral lands and premises in said notice mentioned
 and charged with the Composition for tithes for said
 parish, and which lands are more particularly deli-
 =mated and set forth in the Map, Terre Chart, or Ground
 Plan thereof, signed by me, and hereunto annexed. - In
