

It is hereby agreed on by the Honble and Reverend  
George Theobald Bonke Vicar of the Parish of Reddin  
in the Diocese of Lismore and County of Down and  
Mrs Emily Ludworth Improprietrix of the Rectory of the  
of said Parish - and by a Special Vestry duly held  
for said Parish pursuant to the Provision of the 4<sup>th</sup>  
George the 4<sup>th</sup> Chapter 99 - entitled an Act for the  
Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland  
for a limited time - that the sum of one hundred and  
eighty five Pounds shall be paid as the annual Composition  
under the said Act, for all the Tithes payable out  
of said Parish of Reddin in the following proportion  
Namely to the aforesaid George Theobald Bonke Vicar  
eighty Pounds and to the aforesaid Emily Ludworth  
Improprietrix one hundred and five Pounds  
and that the said agreement shall remain fixed and  
invariable for twenty one years -

at the same time Robert Pennington Esq of Reddin  
was elected Commissioner on the part of  
the Parish and the Reverend Henry Archdall on the  
part of the Incumbent to carry into effect the above  
Composition -
