

It is hereby agreed
and Robert Joyce the Vicar of the Parish of Redding
in the Diocese of Lismore and County
of Down and Mrs Smith (underwritten)
Impresarios of the British Litter of
the Parish of Redding aforesaid -
and a Special Vicar who held
for said Parish pursuant to the
Provisions of the 4th year the 4th
Chapter 99 - entitled an Act for
the establishment of Compositors
for Litters in Ireland for a limited
time - that the sum of five
hundred and eighty five Pounds
shall be paid as the amount
composition under the said Act
for all the Litters Grayed out
of said Parish of Redding in the
following proportions - Namely
to the aforesaid Joyce the Vicar
the sum of eight
Pounds and to the aforesaid
Smith the sum of five Pounds
and that the said agreement shall
remain fixed and unchangeable
for twenty one year -

at the same Robert Pendergast Esq
of Mark Hill was elected Commissioner
on the part of the Parish and the Rev
Henry Dechell on the part of
the Incumbent and Impresarios
to carry into effect the above Compositors
