appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act
made in the fourth year of the reign of King George
the fourth entitled "An Act to provide for the establishment
of commissioners for tithes in Ireland for a limited
time"
to ascertain and fix a true and just composition
for all tithes arising growing yielded & payable
within the Parish of Kenagh in the County of Tipperary
do hereby certify that the true and just amount
of composition for all tithes whatever within the said
Parish, is three hundred and fifty pounds by
the year, which sum is due and payable to the
Rev. Cathedral Prebendary as a composition for the
tithe claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of
said Parish, and we do further certify that the
average price of wheat, being the corn principally
grown in such County for the period of seven
years ending on November the 1st 1821 is thirty
eight shillings and eight pence halfpenny by the
bushel - Dated this 14th day of August 1826
