

Mr Francis Mandeville and James Grove White Esqrs Commissioners appointed and sworn under and by Statute of an Act made in the 24th year of the Reign of King George the Fourth (entitled an Act for providing for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time) to ascertain and take as true and just Compositions for the Rectorial and Vicarial tithes arising growing and yielding or paying within the Parish of Newcastle in the Diocese of Connor and County of Down - Do hereby certify that by an Act of Vestry laid before us bearing date the nineteenth day of April Inst. & held in and for the Parish of Newcastle - We find that the Rev. Charles Luckey L. L. D. Rector of the said Parish of Newcastle has agreed with the Parsonages of said Parish to take the sum of One Hundred and forty Pounds three Shillings and six pence as an Annual Composition for the Rectorial or two third parts of the tithes of said Parish for twenty years from the first day of May next - And We also find that at the Vestry above stated the Rev. James Hill Vicar of the said Parish of Newcastle has agreed with the Parsonages of said Parish to take the sum of One Hundred Pounds as an Annual Composition for the Vicarial or one third part of the tithes of said Parish for twenty years from the first day of May next - Now We the above named Commissioners in pursuance of the Power vested in us do confirm the agreements so made by the Rector and Vicar of Newcastle as above stated - Given under our hands this 25th day of April 1825
