W Francis Mandeville and James Grove White Esqrs
Commissioners appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act
made in the 4th year of the Reign of King George the 4th intitled an
Act for providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just
Composition for the Rectorial and Vicarial Tithes arising growing yielding
or paying within the Parish of Newcastle in the Diocese of Lismore
and County of Tipperary do hereby certify that by an Act of Vestry
laid before us bearing date the 19th day of April instant and held
in and for the Parish of Newcastle, We find that the Reverend
Charles Tuckey S. L. D, Vicar of the said Parish of Newcastle has
agreed with the Parishioners of said Parish to take the sum of £140
= 3. 6. as an annual Composition for the Rectorial or two third
part of the Tithes of said Parish for 21 years from the 1st day
of May next. And we also find that at the vestry above
stated the Reverend James Hill Vicar of the said Parish of
New Castle has agreed with the Parishioners of said Parish to
take the sum of £100 as an annual Composition for the Vicarial
or one third part of the Tithes of said Parish for 21 years from
the 1st day of May next, Now we the above named Comrs^{rs}
in pursuance of the power vested in us do confirm the agreement
so made by the Rector and Vicar of Newcastle as above stated —
