W^o Francis Mandeville and James Grove Mide Esq^{rs} Commissioners appointed and Sworn under and by virtue of an Act Made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth (entitled an Act for providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time) to ascertain and see a true and just Composition for the Rectorial and Vicarial Tithes arising growing yielding or Paying within the Parish of Newcastle in the Diocese of Lismore and County of Tipperary do hereby Certify that by an Act of Vestry laid before Us bearing date the ~~seventeenth~~^{nine} day of April Instant and held in and for the Parish of Newcastle We find that the Rev^d Charles Tucker Esq^r Vicar of the said Parish of Newcastle had agreed with the Parsonages of said Parish to take the sum of One hundred and forty Pounds three shillings and six pence as an Annual Composition for the Rectorial or two third part of the Tithes of said Parish for 21 years from the first day of May next And We also find that at the Vestry above stated the Rev^d James Hill Vicar of the said Parish of Newcastle had agreed with the Parsonages of said Parish to take the sum of One hundred Pounds as an annual Composition for the Vicarial or one third part of the Tithes of said Parish for twenty years from the first day of May next Now We the above named Commissioners in pursuance of the power vested in us do confirm the Agreement so made by the Rector & Vicar of Newcastle as above stated Given under our hands the 28th day of April 1825 = James G. Mide
