the Rev. Thomas Leko as Rector of said Parish —

And we do further Certify that the average  
price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in  
such County for the period of seven years ending on the  
first day of November One thousand eight hundred and  
twenty one is One pound - eighteen shillings and eight  
pence halfpenny per Barrell — Given under our  
hands this 28<sup>th</sup> day of April 1828 —
