

Mr Michael Phillips and James Jones Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth, intituled, an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising, growing, or payable within the Parish of Newcastle in the County of Wicklow do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish, is Six hundred and Twenty one pounds eleven shillings, and seven pence half penny by the year of which sum of Six hundred and Twenty one Pounds eleven shillings and seven pence half penny, the sum of Two hundred and eighty eight pounds nine shillings, and two pence half penny is due and payable to the Reverend Messrs Macklin as a composition for the Tithes claimed by him as Lay Impropriator and owner of the Rectorial Tithes of the following townlands in said Parish as specified in the book of appointment viz, Newtown Mount-Kennedy, Quarry Farm, Monahan, Kilmachulka, Lower Ballynahinch, Upper Ballynahinch, Kildea, Lower Cilla Hill, Upper Cilla Hill, Incedder, Keelogue, Inman, Cornsilla, Knockballincarrig, or, Knockadret, Tammore, Knockfodda, Knockrathmole, Knockrathen, Liffone, Inman, Cooldross, Ballyboughlin, Ballyphilip, Kilcote, Hannas holding, Ballydowna, Woodstock, Ballycrose, Croon, and Kilquade.

The sum of Fifty five pounds twelve shillings and eight pence is due and payable to Earl Fitzwilliam as Lay Impropriator, and owner of the Rectorial Tithes of the following townlands in said Parish as specified in the book of appointment, viz, Blackditch, Leamore Leabeg, Newcastle, Liffin, Killadreenan, and Kilmullen.
